Catalina Saavedra



■ DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT

It inspires me making a film about the crimes that took place in Alto Hospicio, because various social, political and cultural elements of our Chilean identity were intertwined in a horrifying crime. A marginal Chile reveals the abuse of power exercised by different levels of government, the banality of institutions in its most incompetent and profane version.







SUBMERSIBLE

A handmade narco sub is on the verge of sinking and losing its precious cargo due to a mechanical failure. The three crew members are forced to open the forbidden cargo cabin to distribute the weight and save the ship. Next to the cargo they find a special "gift" for the buyer: a young girl, gagged and in terrible shape. The boat, barely big enough for three to begin with, becomes a steaming powder cake of fears, desires and greed.

■ DIRECTOR'S BIOGRAPHY

Alfredo has a post graduate degree on scriptwriting from and an BA in Film and Video. He premiered his first feature film, the critically acclaimed and award-studded *Open Wound*, a historic drama, in 2013. *Submersible* is his second feature film project as writer and director.

■ DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT

A small, confined and claustrophobic place. A fragile fiberglass structure, low ceiling chambers, poorly lit; the constant trembling and the unstable feeling of being underwater. A drug sub is not designed to be luxurious or friendly with its crew. The audience will feel the heat, the smell, the poor sanitary conditions and the extreme confinement, reinforcing the suspense and mystery around these four characters.



And I think it is very universal for our entire generation of thirties.

Ben has directed many well-known commercials. *The Drifters* is his feature film debut.

A young and promising French actress, she starred in the movie *Kings for a Day* (2017) and the TV series *En Famille*.

Jonathan Ajayi


Jonathan is an actor known for Gone (After Lysistrata) (2018), and Hallelujah (2017).

It's a relationship movie on every level, between the young lovers, also between the film-makers and the audience, and finally between the UK and everyone else. The Drifters is my love letter from Britain to the rest of the world on the eve of Brexit. I think of it as a European movie.

Since her husband went to prison, Hala has to face alone the struggles of parenthood and her mental health. Her strength has to come from within as society does not help nor forgive a depressed woman - especially if she's a mother.

■ DIRECTOR'S BIOGRAPHY

Hisham Sagr

was born in Cairo and has more than ten years of experience as an editor in the Egyptian film industry. Saqr has worked with a number of acclaimed Egyptian directors. *Certified Mail* is his first feature film.

■ CAST INFORMATION

Acclaimed Egyptian actress, she is known for the movies *Ouija* (2006), *Tyrant* (2014), and Media Luna's *Sheikh Jackson* (2017).

Passant Shawky

■ DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT

I made a film about the idea of loss and how one can surprisingly find the inner strength to deal with it. It is about how a normal person who is emotionally fragile copes with incomprehensible emotions such as anxiety and depression that lead to suicidal thoughts. I wanted my subject to be a woman with a young child who is under special scrutiny in society. Her complex emotions and how she finds a way to cope with them is what I am examining in my film.

He debuted as a film director in 2007 with the short *Gabiano con un Sola B.* In 2015, he directed his first feature film *Un Posto Sicuro* based on the book written with Marco D'Amore.

■ DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT

It's hard to look within yourself with sincerity, we need some kind of encouragement. The same is for the protagonists of this story: they will need love, rage, dreams, and fears before reaching that final taste of achievement. You are how you feel about yourself, not how you see yourself, the mirror is always lying.









SKIN WALKER

Regine is a fragile young woman trying to build a new life – safer and happier than the one she had as a child. Escaping her trauma is not so easy however, and when her grandmother is brutally murdered, Regine must return to the village she once left and revisit the gruesome horrors of her past to protect herself and her family.

■ DIRECTOR'S BIOGRAPHY

Christian Neuman

is a Luxembourg born artist and filmmaker. He is best known for his work in the fashion industry as the creative director behind several brands and campaigns in. Trained at London Film School, his shorts and fashion films have screened at festivals worldwide. Skin Walker is his feature film debut.

■ CAST INFORMATION

Amber Anderson

She is a British actress, known for the film *Your Highness* (2011) and the TV series *BlackMirror*. She will play Jane Fairfax in the 2020 movie adaptation of Jane Austen's *Emma*.

Jefferson Hall

The British actor starred in the successful theatrical reboot of *Halloween* (2018) and also is no stranger to the small screen with roles in TV saga *Vikings* and HBO's worldwide fantasy phenomenon *Game of Thrones*.

Udo Kier

Udo is a German actor who has appeared in over 200 films such as *Downsizing* (2017), *Iron Sky* (2012) and *Dogville* (2003) and collaborated with acclaimed filmmakers like Lars von Trier and Gus van Sant.

■ DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT

My intention was to create a film that deals with the protagonist's descent into madness. I was interested in creating a specific atmosphere, close to a gothic melodramatic tale. Regine's childhood trauma causes a behavior that borders on paranoid schizophrenia. The film is set in an undefined time or place, with the intention to reflect the protagonist's inner psychological landscape. To some degree I am giving up on linear storytelling, with the hope of the film being experienced by gliding through time in a dreamlike and surreal state.







THE FRIENDLY MAN

After a video gone viral, a successful rockstar is trapped in a controversy that involves the death of a police officer. From being awed to being despised by everyone, he embarks on a journey through the night of Sao Paulo, where he will have to face his own demons and the current political turmoil.

■ DIRECTOR'S BIOGRAPHY

Iberê Carvalho

The Friendly Man (O Homem Cordial) will be the second feature film for award-winning Brazilian filmmaker Iberê Carvalho. His first film, The Last Drive-In Theater (O Último Cine Drive-in), was named best Brazilian film of 2015 by the newspaper Folha de São Paulo.

■ CAST BIOGRAPHY

Paulo Miklos

Is one of Brazil's greatest rock stars, best known for his former work as front man of rock band "Titas". He has also been successful as an actor, starring in films such as *The Invader* (O Invasor).

Thaíde

Is a Brazilian rapper from São Paulo who has been rapping professionally since 1988. Recently he has also worked as a TV presenter and an actor, staring in films such as *Two Rabbits*.

■ DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT

I must say that when this film was being written and shot none of us would imagine that Brazil would elect a far-right candidate as president. It is in this Brazil that the story takes place. The emergence of a wave of hatred and intolerance with strong traces of fascism is shown from the point of view of a white, sixty-year-old, heterosexual, rich man that, from his privileged social status, finds himself impotent, without knowing how to react to this reality that presents itself.









BOY MEETS GUN

When the bored out evolutionary philosopher Maarten Moreau gets caught up in a robbery, he accidentally gets hold of the murder weapon. Seized by a renewed appetite for life, Maarten decides to keep the gun. A true romance blossoms between the boy and the gun, not without consequences.

■ DIRECTOR'S BIOGRAPHY

Joost van Hezik

Joost (1982) has a background as a theatre director. Over the years he repositioned himself in film, directing the absurdist drama series *TreurTeeVee* and the short film *The Funeral of the Shy. Boy Meets Gun* marks his first feature length film.

■ CAST BIOGRAPHY

Eelco Smits

An acclaimed Dutch theatre actor working for ITA with world famous director Ivo van Hove. He received the prestigious Paul Steenbergen-penning. *Boy Meets Gun* is his first lead role in a film.

Victor Ijdens


Is a fresh new face on the Dutch film scene. He starred in the short film *Radio Voorwaarts* before moving on to his first feature film *Boy Meets Gun*.

■ DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT

I think we all long for personal change, in one way or another. I know I do anyway. Eat better, exercise more, meditate, fulfill my dreams, focus more on my career, or less, just be a better person in general! And this belief in endless personal evolution seems to have risen to an unquestionable and almost holy status nowadays. With this film, I wanted to question this belief. Because what are we changing into? And is that really better? Maarten finds a gun, which acts as a magic wand that turns him into a stronger person. But is that good? Can the road towards becoming someone else, someone better, actually lead us to darker places?







WE HAD IT COMING

Anna, a young woman in her 20s, just lost her sister and cannot let the man responsible get away with it. But with limited financial sources and no lawyer willing to help her, together with her girlfriend Olivia, she decides to travel in the whereabouts of the criminal, her sister's pimp, and seek justice.

■ DIRECTOR'S BIOGRAPHY

Paul Barbeau

Born in 1971 in Montreal, Paul has become an experienced and successful producer, with production credits such as *Arrival* by Denis Villeneuve. We Had It Coming is his third feature as a director after We Have Forever and Winter Passed.

■ CAST BIOGRAPHY

Natalie Krill

Natalie has been on stage from a very early age, ever since she signed herself up for dance lessons at the age of 6. Today she is a rising star in Canada's film scene, best known for her 2016 I GBT-drama Below Her Mouth.

Alexia Fast

An award-winning Canadian actress of film and television. She is best known for her work on Netflix's *Dirk Gently's Holistic Detective Agency* and *Bates Motel* but has also starred in blockbusters such as *Jack Reacher*.

Erin Agostino

■ DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT

I wanted to make a Film Noir about a character struggling to move beyond grief and looking for some form of justice in the world. Like most male directors, I projected myself into making the lead a man, but once the script was completed, I decided on changing the first name and making the protagonist a woman. This allowed me not to apply any preconceived gender filter to the character and truly make her unique as she is portrayed so powerfully by Natalie Krill.

Simon is a German actor who appeared in 13 Minutes (2017), crime series Tatort and TV comedy show Dr. Klein.

■ DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT

The film is about dependency, loss of control and trying to make the right decisions to become independent. There's an appeal in the thought that it's not important if you lead a life adapted to social standards or walk your path as an outcast. Her memories were the basis for my film and while some elements were invented, most were not. I feel extremely grateful to be able to share Sara's story with the world.




